DCC Works Schedule – Trees in Hurn Road

This is a follow-up to the letter that we previously delivered to you.

Top of River Way: 116-118 Hurn Road

3 English Oaks

1. Remove deadwood
2. Reduce overhanging branches
3. Reshape as necessary

Plant one new tree

River Way to St Catherine's Way: 82-116 Hurn Road

6 Cypress; 7 English Oak; 11 Monterey Pine; 7 Scots Pine; 1 Silver Birch

4. Remove deadwood
5. Reduce overhanging branches
6. Crown lift as required
7. Ivy Band as necessary
8. Reshape as necessary

FELL: all Cypress; immature Monterey Pine opposite 114; 2 immature Monterey Pine opposite 112; immature Scots Pine opposite 112; 2 immature Monterey Pine opposite 110; immature Scots Pine opposite 110; immature Monterey Pine opposite 102; 2 multi-stemmed Scots Pine opposite 98; under-developed Monterey Pine opposite 90; immature Scots Pine opposite 90

Felling 18 out of 32 trees to encourage stronger growth in the remaining trees and to make room, it is hoped, to plant replacements. Councillor Sue Spittle is pursuing this and will contact *directly affected* residents when more is known.

Opposite River Way to Marlow Drive: backing Ambleside; Grasmere; Lynton

6 Scots Pine; 1 Rowan

9. Remove deadwood
10. Reduce overhanging branches
11. Crown lift as required
12. Reshape as necessary

FELL: the Rowan which is dying. Plant a new tree.

On Roundabout: Top of St Catherine's Way

4 English Oak; 1 Norway Maple; 2 Red Oak; 4 Scots Pines;

13. Remove deadwood
14. Reduce overhanging branches
15. Crown lift as required
16. Reshape as necessary

St Catherine's Way to The Grove: 2-80 Hurn Road

2 Scots Pine; 2 Silver Birch; 1 Sycamore

17. Remove deadwood
18. Reduce overhanging branches
19. Crown lift as required
20. Ivy Band as necessary
21. Reshape as necessary

Marlow Drive to the Grove roundabout: 1-73 Hurn Road

2 Beech; 2 Cherry; 8 Cypress; 40 English Oak; 2 Monterey Pine; 1 Myrobalan Plum; 16 Scots Pine; 2 Silver Birch; 3 Sycamore

22. Remove deadwood
23. Reduce overhanging branches
24. Crown lift as required
25. Ivy Band as necessary
26. Reshape as necessary

FELL: all Cypress; under-developed Oak opposite 31-33; Cherry opposite 31-33; under-developed Oak opposite 55; under-developed Oak opposite 61-63; 2 under-developed Scots Pine opposite 63-65; multi-stemmed Silver Birch opposite 67; under-developed Monterey Pine opposite 67 – plant replacement; 3 immature Scots Pine opposite 71; 1 multi-stemmed Scots Pine opposite 73

Felling 20 out of 76 trees to encourage stronger growth in the remaining trees
